

New American Cursive Contest!



The 11th Annual **New American Cursive**® Handwriting contest is underway!

Entries are already coming in and we encourage your school or your child to enter soon. The official cut off for postmark date is **Wednesday April 10**.

Instructions:

Each entry needs to be written on 8 ½ x 11 white paper, lined or unlined, or use one of the reproducible pages in the back of your *New American Cursive* workbook. The sample can be written with either pen or pencil. Philippians 4:8 or The Pledge of Allegiance can be used (but not required) for the handwriting sample.

Three handwriting specialists will judge the entries submitted. They will score the cursive entries on legibility, neatness, shape, slant, spacing, size, fluidity, spelling and accuracy.

Entries will be judged by grade level.

Contest rules

1. This contest is open to all **New American Cursive** students through the eighth grade.
2. On the **front** of the entry page the student needs to include age, grade and gender.
3. On the **back** of the entry page the student's full name; address or school should be written.

Include a method of winner notification, i.e. email address, phone number, mailing address, etc.

4. Entries need to be postmarked by **April 10th**.
